Willie Gray Caraway, 84, of Laurel, died Friday, April 24, 2015, at his residence.

Funeral services will be held at 11:00 a.m. Monday, April 27, 2015, at Immaculate Conception Catholic Church, with burial to follow at Lake Park Hills Cemetery. Father Mike Thornton and Pastor Timothy Beard will officiate. Mr. Caraway was a farmer. He worked for Commercial Credit for 39 years and Howard Industries for 14 years. He was a veteran of the U S.
