June 26, 1914 - February 22, 2013

Woodrow Wilson Bush, 98, died on Friday, February 22, 2013, at the Jackson Madison County General Hospital in Jackson, Tennessee.

He was born June 26, 1914, in Laurel, Mississippi, the son of the late Charles H and Frances Elizabeth Drennan Bush. A lifelong resident of Laurel, he was a member of the F & A Masonic Lodge 414 of Jones County, the Shriner Hamasa Temple of Meridian, and a member of the First United Methodist Church of Laurel.
